BOOTH FEE FOR TWO-DAY EVENT:

Information and Non-Profit Group:	\$50
Food Booths	\$200 + \$50 refundable cleaning deposit
Native American Craft and Novelty	\$125 + \$50 refundable cleaning deposit

BOOTH FEES are non-refundable and must be paid prior to 9 am Saturday, August 1, 2009. Please include the \$50 cleaning fee as a separate money order if you expect immediate refund Sunday, August 2, 2009.

VENDOR PASSES: Two (2) vendor passes per agreement will be issued. All persons 12 years of age and older must purchase admission tickets at front gate both days. Admission is \$6 per day. Pre-sale tickets may be purchased at \$1 per ticket through Royal Contestants and/or the museum office. Presale ends Monday, July 27, 2009. No exceptions can be made.

UPON FULL PAYMENT: A booth space will be assigned to you. Specific requests of booth locations will be acknowledged on a first come, first served basis only. Your \$50 deposit will be refunded if your space is left in same condition it was in prior to your arrival. All your trash must be in waste containers.

PERMITS, CRAFT VENDORS: The Department of Fish & Game regulations require that wild game or animal parts are not to be sold without special State & Federal permits. **PERMITS MUST BE CURRENT AND DISPLAYED.**

CRAFT VENDORS MUST HAVE CURRENT SELLERS PERMIT: CONTACT STATE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION (559) 440-5330

FOR TEMPORARY SELLER'S PERMIT. You will be responsible to acquire these permits and/or any fines due to lack of. You may be asked to close your booth if these permits are not properly displayed for county inspectors. Vendors should have a Native American theme.

PERMITS, FOOD VENDORS: MUST HAVE CURRENT HEALTH PERMIT. CONTACT COUNTY OF MADERA FOR

The Sierra Mono Museum is not responsible for any dispute between vendor and any government agency for any reason at any time.

BOOTH SIZE IS 10 X 10'. Vendors must bring their own set-up, shade, table, chairs, etc. Vendors who space exceeds 10 x 10' will be asked to pay for an additional space and cleaning fee.

SET UP: No One is allowed to set up booths before Friday, August 1st at 5:00 pm, the day before the event. Premises must be vacated by 7 pm Sunday, August 2, 2009.

CAMPING RULES: ABSOLUTELY NO ILLEGAL DRUGS OR ALCOHOL. If you are under the influence, you will be escorted off the grounds. This eviction will include your entire party. Camping is first come first served. No open campfires. Gates will be closed and locked at midnight to 7 am. **NO PETS.** No Parking on the grass. Camping fee is \$10 and will be charged at registration. You must display your camping permit in plain sight for security. No exceptions. **MOTOR HOMES & CAMPERS WILL NEED TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN GENERATOR AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLUG IN TO RECREATION CENTER POWER.**

The Sierra Mono Museum, Indian Fair Days Committee, and/or the North Fork Boosters will not be responsible or held liable for any lost, stolen, or damaged property or personal injury. Space is limited. Please use only the space you need. Please be courteous to your neighbors and respect your Elders. You are responsible for your children at all times. The North Fork Recreation Center is Private property – do not trespass. **PLEASE NO DOGS.**

- Please be courteous to your neighbors and remember to RESPECT YOUR ELDERS!
- NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS
- you are responsible for YOUR children at ALL TIMES!
- The area surrounding the Pow Wow ground is private property. PLEASE DO NOT TRESPASS!
- The Sierra Mono Museum or the North Fork Boosters are not responsible for theft, accidents, or injuries.
- Gates will close at MIDNIGHT (Saturday Night)
- VENDORS: we have a local recycle group who will collect your used oil.
- Motor homes must have a generator. No Plug ins will be allowed. All power is required for dancers sound equipment.
